# **DIRECTIONS FOR USE**

### **Routine Maintenance**

Safety:

Shelf life:

- 1. Dry clean the floor with a Bona Microfiber Dusting pad, scissor mop, etc. to remove all loose dirt.
- 2. Dilute Bona SuperSport Cleaner with cold water for routine cleaning, 50 ml to 5 L. Clean the floor with the solution and let the surface dry sufficiently before resuming traffic.
- 3. For heavy contamination, use a dilution of 100 ml to 5 L water.

Note: On wood floors use as little liquid as possible as excess amounts may cause swelling and permanent damage to the flooring.

## Large areas

- 1. For larger areas Bona SuperSport Cleaner is suitable for use in an auto scrubber, such as a Bona PowerScrubber, with white brushes. Use a dilution of 100 ml to 10 L cold water for routine maintenance or 200 ml to 10 L water in the case of heavier soiling.
- 2. Always fill the tank with clean water prior to use.
- 3. Run the machine along, never across, parquet boards.
- 4. Water loss from the machine must not exceed 1 L / 100 m². Test by adding 10 litres of water to the tank and check the remaining water after 100 m<sup>2</sup>, 9 litres should remain in the return tank.
- 5. Water should be removed promptly, make sure not to leave puddles when turning the machine.
- 6. Keep the suction strip clean and in good condition. Replace annually or if the machine is leaving too much water on the floor.
- 7. Do not use aggressive brushes or pads on the surface. Aggressive pads / brushes may scratch and wear the surface. The milder the pad/brush, the less the wear.
