Bona SuperSport Deep Clean is designed for occasional cleaning of indoor sports floors to remove black heel marks, handball glue, etc. together with the build-up of body fats and other contaminants that may make the surface slippery.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- 1. Dry clean the floor with a Bona Microfiber Dusting pad, scissor mop, etc. to remove all loose dirt
- 2. Apply the diluted product to a section of the floor using a mop, spray or auto scrubber, with no suction.
- 3. Allow the solution 3 5 minutes to dissolve the dirt. Scrub the section using a buffing machine or an auto scrubber, equipped with a white or red pad, and remove all the dissolved dirt.
- 4. Finally, use the auto scrubber, with clean water, to clean the floor and remove any remaining residues.

For spot cleaning of stubborn marks, increase the concentration to 1:2 (Bona SuperSport Deep Clean to water). Apply the solution to the affected area and allow 3-5 minutes for the solution to dissolve the dirt. Scrub the area with a buffing machine (e.g. Bona FlexiSand) and a red pad. Immediately remove the dissolved dirt with an auto scrubber or mop and bucket with clean water, before moving on to the next section.

After using Bona SuperSport Deep Clean at a high concentration it is recommended that the floor is allowed a minimum 2-3 hours drying time before resuming use.

Note: On wood floors, keep the amount of water used to a minimum. Pay attention to gaps in the floor; do not allow excessive amounts of cleaning solution to seep into open gaps.

Recommendations for Handball Glue

If handball glue is frequently used, plan for weekly deep cleaning, hardened handball glue will be more difficult to remove. Bona recommends using Select Profcare Handball Resin or other dispersion-based resins. This handball glue type is approved for use by players and is easier to remove than traditional glue (source: Team Denmark).

Large spills of hardened material may need to be removed mechanically using a spatula or similar; care must be taken not to damage the floor. The standard dilution (1:5) is usually effective on handball glue.
